Relative to memorializing and acknowledging the accomplishments of the late Honorable Alfred San Nicolas Flores, former Assemblyman, Senator, Commissioner, Businessman, and Master *Lancheru*, on the occasion of his passing, and to extending condolences to his family, on behalf of the people of Guam.

1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA'TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS,** our island has suffered the loss of one of its most
4 prominent sons and island citizens with the passing of the Honorable Alfred
5 San Nicolas Flores; and

6 **WHEREAS,** on June 20, 1916, the late Honorable Alfred San Nicolas
7 Flores was born to Jose Duenas Flores and Rafaela Lujan San Nicolas, and
8 was raised by his stepmother, Margarita L. Flores; and

9 **WHEREAS,** the late Honorable Alfred San Nicolas Flores married Ester
10 Paulino Duenas on February 18, 1939, and together they are blessed with
11 three (3) children: Mrs. Lucille Flores Leon Guerrero, Mrs. May Flores-
12 Hannah, Mr. Fred Flores, and a reared son, Mr. Roy P. Duenas; ten (10)
13 grandchildren: Giovanna, Alfred, Mark, Brian, Ester, Tina, David, Anna
14 Maria, Tera and Fred; and thirteen (13) great grandchildren: Kristen, Danielle,
15 Aaron, Giana, Alfred, Sophia, Olivia, David, Rachael, Johnalyn, Brianne,
16 Erwin Jr., and Aubrey; and

17 **WHEREAS,** the late Honorable Alfred San Nicolas Flores, will forever
18 be remembered as a man of humble beginnings, a Businessman and a well-
19 known Master *Lancheru* by profession; and

20 **WHEREAS,** the late Honorable Alfred San Nicolas Flores, as a Master
21 *Lancheru*, tended hundreds of acres of land, raised eight hundred (800) head
22 of carabao and cattle, cultivated and seeded fruits and vegetables, and

1 established the Flores Poultry Farm with two hundred (200) chickens, which
2 grew to an astonishing seventy-five thousand (75,000) chickens which
3 produced seventy thousand (70,000) eggs a day; and

4 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Alfred San Nicolas Flores worked
5 throughout his life serving his community and advancing the public good,
6 serving with honor and distinction as a soldier of the Guam Militia; an
7 Assemblyman in the pre-Organic Act Congress; as a Senator in the Fourth,
8 Fifth, Seventh, Ninth and Tenth Guam Legislatures; and as Commissioner
9 (Mayor) of *Inarajan* for one term in 1976; and

10 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Alfred San Nicolas Flores as, part of a
11 group that founded the Democratic Party of Guam, and being well known for
12 his “off the cuff” and passionate campaign speeches that earned him the
13 nickname “Davy Crockett”, became a pioneer in shaping the political
14 landscape of Guam; and

15 **WHEREAS**, during his tenure as a Senator, the late Honorable Alfred
16 San Nicolas Flores authored public laws that built subdivisions in *Astumbo*,
17 *Inarajan*, *Talofof*, *Merizo* and *Umatac* as well as what is now *Inarajan* Middle
18 School, and as a man of the land, he fought for the advancement of the
19 farming community by reducing the water rates for farmers and establishing
20 farmer’s insurance; and

21 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Alfred San Nicolas Flores served on
22 various boards and commissions, including: the Selective Service Board, of

1 which he was a member for twenty-one (21) years; the Guam Housing and
2 Urban Renewal Authority (GHURA) Board of Commissioners; the Guam
3 Farmers Cooperative Association; and the Soil and Water Conservation
4 District; and

5 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Alfred San Nicolas Flores had been
6 active in numerous civic and religious organizations, including, the Parish
7 Council and Holy Name Society at Saint Joseph’s Church in *Inarajan*, and the
8 Boy Scouts of America; now, therefore, be it


9 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina’Trenta Na*
10 *Liheslaturan Guåhan*, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people of
11 Guam, does hereby recognize and acknowledge the accomplishments and
12 achievements of the late Honorable Alfred San Nicolas Flores, a pioneer in
13 Guam politics and a fighter for the people; and be it further

14 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina’Trenta Na*
15 *Liheslaturan Guåhan*, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people of
16 Guam, does hereby extend its condolences and heartfelt sympathy to the
17 family of the late Honorable Alfred San Nicolas Flores on his passing; and be
18 it further


19 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee in

- 3 Felix P. Camacho, *I Maga'lahen Guåhan*.


