## 1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I* 2 *MINA'TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:

WHEREAS, Kurt Scott Kaleo Moylan is the Founder of Moylan's
Insurance Underwriters, Inc.; NetCare Life & Health Insurance Company;

Moy Communications, Inc.; Pohnpei Pepper Factory; Colonial Investment
 Company, Inc.; First Net Insurance Company; and Equitable Adjusting &
 Service Company; and

WHEREAS, Kurt Moylan also has ownership of a number of other
companies, including, Federal Communications (distributor of Sony);
Hardware Inc., dba Guam, True Value Hardware; and The Zipper Factory;
and

8 WHEREAS, this illustrious businessman was also an incorporator and 9 the Chairman of the Board for Citizens Security Bank, and still holds the seat 10 of Chairman for Citizens Security Bank/ANZ; and

WHEREAS, his career on Guam began in 1961, first as Assistant General
Manager, and then General Manager of F.L. Moylan Company & Moylan
Motors Co., Inc., distributor of Motorola, Sherwin Williams, 3M, Winchester,
Westinghouse, Volkswagen, Mercedes Benz, Porsche, Chrysler and Subaru
products; and

WHEREAS, concurrent with growing his businesses, former Lieutenant
 Governor Moylan also began his political career, serving for two (2) years as a
 Senator in the 8<sup>th</sup> Guam Legislature; and

WHEREAS, at the end of his term, he became one (1) of four (4)incorporators of the Republican Party of Guam; and

WHEREAS, in 1969, President Richard Nixon appointed him as
Secretary of Guam (equivalent to Lieutenant Governor), together with Carlos

G. Camacho as appointed Governor; and the team became Guam's first
 elected Governor and Lieutenant Governor of Guam a year later; and

WHEREAS, in 1971, former Lieutenant Governor Moylan established Moylan's Insurance Underwriters, Inc., with three (3) employees, writing property and casualty insurance; today, the company has grown to become a multi-line insurance agency on Guam, the CNMI, the Republic of Palau, the Republic of the Marshall Islands, and the Federated States of Micronesia, employing hundreds of people and giving back thousands of dollars to the community; and

WHEREAS, Lieutenant Governor Moylan again served as a Senator in
the 16th Guam Legislature, but ended his political career in 1982, which
allowed him to shift all his attention back to his family business; and

WHEREAS, he is considered a role model to many because of histireless work ethic and business acumen; and

WHEREAS, former Lieutenant Governor Moylan has received a number of accolades, including being chosen as the "1990 Executive of the Year", being named one of the "Top 100 Businessmen of the Century" by *Guam Business Magazine* in 1999; and being mentioned in *Who's Who in Chamorro History v.3, Who's Who in the West, Personalities in the West and Mid-West, Who's Who in American Politics, Personalities of Americans,* and *Men of Achievement*; and

WHEREAS, on top of his personal success over the years, former

Lieutenant Governor Moylan has given back to our island through many
 generous donations and contributions to various non-profit organizations and
 scholarship programs; now, therefore, be it
