Relative to remembering and memorializing the late Dr. Thomas W. Barlow for his outstanding contributions and service to the education profession on Guam and to the people of Guam.

## BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN 2 GUÅHAN:

WHEREAS, Dr. Thomas W. Barlow devoted much of his life and energies to improving the well-being of children in the Pacific; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Barlow joined the staff at Pacific Resources for Education and Learning (PREL) in 1996, becoming its Chief Operating Officer in 2000, and was selected to lead the organization in 2003, as PREL's President and Chief Executive Officer; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Barlow had over thirty (30) years of experience in education and held doctorates in the disciplines of language arts education and administration, curriculum, and instruction. He served as a classroom educator, school administrator, and designer/administrator of state, regional, and national education department programs; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Barlow distinguished himself through a host of reports and studies for state education departments and was appointed to participate in federal evaluative efforts; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Barlow was the author of numerous articles, curricula, and monographs on issues facing education, particularly school reform and health education. He wrote for medical and educational audiences, often with prevention and youth foci. He collaborated with a group of national experts on special education issues to produce a monograph series on the health needs of children with special needs; and

WHEREAS, as a lifetime educator, Dr. Barlow worked tirelessly in the 1 past thirteen (13) years to build and manage an educational research and 2 3 development organization that has benefited thousands of schools and youth. 4 He had a vision, believed in participatory and consultative processes, and was 5 willing to listen and learn; and WHEREAS, Dr. Barlow did not limit himself to his work at PREL. He 6 7 was one of the people instrumental in forging improved collaboration between education agencies in the northern and southern Pacific and was 8 9 active in his community and served on numerous boards; now, therefore, be it 10 **RESOLVED**, that I Mina'Trenta Na Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby, on 11 behalf of the people of Guam, recognize the outstanding contributions of the 12 late Dr. Thomas W. Barlow to education on Guam and the Pacific and does 13 extend its most sincere condolences to his family; and be it further RESOLVED, that the Speaker certify, and the Legislative Secretary 14 15 attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to the family of the late Dr. Thomas W. Barlow; to the 16 17 Chairwoman of the Board of Directors for PREL, Dr. Claire Poumele; to the Acting President of PREL, Dr. Paul Dumas; to the Honorable Madeleine Z. 18 19 Bordallo, Guam Delegate to Congress, U.S. House of Representatives; and to
