11 DJ's and morning radio shows, including Ray Gibson, Joe Cunningham aka  
12 "Uncle Tote", Chris "*Malafunkshun*" Barnett, Hutch Walsh and Jeff Evans of  
13 "Hutch and Jeff", and Rick Nauta and Ronnie Perez from The Rick and Ronnie  
14 Show; and

15          **WHEREAS**, Hit Radio 100 continues to be one of Guam's foremost  
16 corporate citizens, applying its resources toward numerous worthy causes on  
17 Guam; and

18          **WHEREAS**, the Hit Radio 100 Rick & Ronnie Un-Invitational Golf  
19 Tournament has contributed nearly Eight Thousand Dollars (\$8,000) to the  
20 Make-A-Wish Foundation since 2004; and

21          **WHEREAS**, the management and employees of Hit Radio 100 actively  
22 demonstrate their outstanding commitment to the community by donating

2 programs as the Make-A-Wish Foundation, Kid-Care Photo ID program,
