- 3 companies; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Mr. Emelio Y. Uy transformed the small business into one
- 5 of the largest and highly recognized retail stores on island. From a modular-
- 6 house office of 1,200 square feet with two (2) employees, National Office
- 7 Supply has grown to two (2) branches, totaling 21,000 square feet of floor
- 8 space with a total of thirty (30) employees; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Mr. Emelio Uy's entrepreneurial spirit and strongest
- 10 characteristics were indisputably manifested in the face of very challenging
- 11 conditions and overcoming various disasters, such as, a fire in 1991, a decline
- in tourism in the late 1990's, several major typhoons and post 9/11; and
- WHEREAS, the success of National Office Supply is the result of Mr.
- 14 Uy's commitment to personalize service for every customer. He takes the
- 15 time to greet his customers, know their preferences, and assist them in their
- 16 purchasing needs. If there is ever an issue with a customer, he handles it
