WHEREAS, the Department of Corrections employees have reason to celebrate due to their significant accomplishments in the last year, such as the enactment of the "Prison Industries Act of 2008," the completion of the Department of Justice Consent Decree Order, the Giving Back to the Community Service Project that resulted in savings to the government of Guam of over Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000), and the implementation of the Cost Efficiency/Mitigation Plan that reduced personnel
