Relative to commending and congratulating Madhusudhan "Madhu" Seshadri on his successful five (5) year term on Guam, and to extending *Un Dångkulo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse* to him for his service, accomplishments, and contributions to the island of Guam.

1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA'TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS**, since arriving in Guam on 2004, Madhusudhan “Madhu”
4 Seshadri has served as Vice-President/Cards Business and Marketing Head,
5 and since 2006, as Vice President and Country Corporate Officer / Business
6 Manager for Citibank Guam, and he served in the critical role of safeguarding
7 and championing the Citigroup franchise; and

8 **WHEREAS**, under Madhusudhan “Madhu” Seshadri’s leadership and
9 client-first philosophy, Citibank Guam expanded its distribution channels for
10 the convenience of their customers, invested in technological enhancements,
11 launched innovative products and services, enhanced customer service,
12 established new client relationships, and contributed towards community
13 development through employee volunteer efforts and philanthropic giving;
14 and

15 **WHEREAS**, Madhusudhan “Madhu” Seshadri worked to make
16 Citibank Guam the leading lender of consumer loans, increasing the
17 distribution channel of Quick Pay locations by three (3) at several Shell
18 Stations, adding seven (7) ATM locations in central and northern Guam,
19 doubling the number of full-service ATM’s from five (5) to eleven (11),
20 launching the Citibank Guam Platinum card, and adding two (2) frequent
21 flyer programs into Citis’ Rewards Card Redemption program -- Continental

1 Airlines' One Pass Miles Program and Philippine Airlines' Mabuhay Miles
2 Program; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Madhusudhan "Madhu" Seshadri will leave behind a
4 financial institution that by the Fourth Quarter of 2009 will offer their
5 customers a larger array of products and services to choose from that will
6 assist them in achieving their financial goals with greater efficiency; and

7 **WHEREAS**, during Madhusudhan "Madhu" Seshadri's oversight of the
8 Citibank Guam business, the Citi Foundation gave Three Hundred Thousand
9 Dollars (\$300,000) in grants, of which Two Hundred Thousand Dollars
10 (\$200,000) went towards general education programs, and more than One
11 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) went to Financial Education and
12 Community Development initiatives. Recipients and beneficiaries of grant
13 funds include: Marcial A. Sablan Elementary School; Inarajan Elementary
14 School; George Washington High School; St. John's School; Big Brothers Big
15 Sisters of Guam; the Salvation Army Guam Chapter; Junior Achievement
16 Guam; Habitat For Humanity Guam; Guam Community College; the
17 University of Guam TRIO Program; and GCA Trades Academy; and

18 **WHEREAS**, Madhusudhan "Madhu" Seshadri guided and supported
19 the Citi Guam's employees' passion to serve the island community through
20 the Citi Global Community Day -- an annual event when employees, along
21 with their families and friends, come together as a global team to share their
22 time, talents, and resources on projects in their respective locale. Citi Guam's

1 Global Community Day events encompassed projects which have positively
2 impacted our environment, our youth and senior citizens, the homeless, and
3 people in need. Projects and beneficiaries include: Holiday meals for Guam
4 Memorial Hospital's Skilled Nursing Unit patients and their families, and for
5 the residents of *Guma Trankilidat*; the Food Drive for the Salvation Army;
6 Sanctuary's Inc.'s 5K Run/Walk; Habitat for Humanity of Guam Rummage
7 Sale; the Clean Up at the War in the Pacific Asan Beach Park; and feeding the
8 needy at *Kusinan Karidat*; and

9 **WHEREAS**, Madhusudhan "Madhu" Seshadri set the example of
10 community service through his active involvement in the Guam Chamber of
11 Commerce, the Sunrise Rotary Club of Guam, and the Junior Achievement
12 Guam Chapter; and

13 **WHEREAS**, Madhusudhan "Madhu" Seshadri, along with his wife
14 Nandini, daughter Aparajita, and son Annirudh, will relocate to Singapore as
15 the Regional Cards Director for Citibank; now, therefore, be it

16 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trenta Na*
17 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the
18 people of Guam, commend and congratulate Madhusudhan "Madhu"
19 Seshadri on his successful term on Guam; and be it further
