- 17 University of Guam TRIO Program; and GCA Trades Academy; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Madhusudhan "Madhu" Seshadri guided and supported
- 19 the Citi Guam's employees' passion to serve the island community through
- 20 the Citi Global Community Day -- an annual event when employees, along
- 21 with their families and friends, come together as a global team to share their
- 22 time, talents, and resources on projects in their respective locale. Citi Guam's

- 1 Global Community Day events encompassed projects which have positively
- 2 impacted our environment, our youth and senior citizens, the homeless, and
- 3 people in need. Projects and beneficiaries include: Holiday meals for Guam
- 4 Memorial Hospital's Skilled Nursing Unit patients and their families, and for
- 5 the residents of Guma Trankilidat; the Food Drive for the Salvation Army;
- 6 Sanctuary's Inc.'s 5K Run/Walk; Habitat for Humanity of Guam Rummage
- 7 Sale; the Clean Up at the War in the Pacific Asan Beach Park; and feeding the
- 8 needy at Kusinan Karidat; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Madhusudhan "Madhu" Seshadri set the example of
- 10 community service through his active involvement in the Guam Chamber of
- 11 Commerce, the Sunrise Rotary Club of Guam, and the Junior Achievement
- 12 Guam Chapter; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Madhusudhan "Madhu" Seshadri, along with his wife
- 14 Nandini, daughter Aparajita, and son Annirudh, will relocate to Singapore as
- 15 the Regional Cards Director for Citibank; now, therefore, be it
