- 3 WHEREAS, U. S. Army First Sergeant Jose San Nicolas Crisostomo
- 4 was born on August 29, 1949; is married to Patricia Duenas Leon Guerrero;
- 5 is a proud father of four (4) children: Tricia, Jeffrey, Dominic Jay and
- 6 Charlotte Marie; and is a loving grandfather to eleven (11) grandchildren;
- 7 and
- 8 WHEREAS, Joe San Nicolas Crisostomo of Inarajan and Talofofo,
- 9 Guam, joined the Army in May 1969 to begin a career of twenty-four (24)
- 10 years in active service; and
- 11 WHEREAS, he was sent to Vietnam right after his basic training in
- 12 California, and later was stationed at Fort Benning, Georgia; Brussels,
- 13 Belgium; St. Louis, Missouri; and Germany, where he was stationed for
- 14 seven (7) years; and
- WHEREAS, Joe retired from the Army in 1993 and has lived in the
- 16 State of Washington since then. In April 2008, he was recalled to active
- 17 duty and went on training at Fort Jackson in South Carolina, and then
- 18 stopped at Fort Lewis in Texas before he was deployed to Kabul,
- 19 Afghanistan in June 2008, as a member of U.S. Forces under North Atlantic
- 20 Treaty Organization (NATO); and

WHEREAS, on August 18, 2009, Sergeant Crisostomo was killed 1 2 while on duty after an improvised explosive device detonated near his convoy in Kabul, Afghanistan; and 3 4 WHEREAS, he is the third (3rd) war casualty from the region for the year 2009 and the 33rd from Micronesia since 2003; now, therefore, be it 5 **RESOLVED**, that I Mina'Trenta Na Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby, 6 7 on behalf of the people of Guam, honoring and memorializing the dedication of the late U.S. Army First Sergeant Joe San Nicolas Crisostomo 8 9 in fighting for our freedom and extending *Un Dångkolo' Na Si Yu'os Ma'ase* 10 to him for the ultimate sacrifice he made for our country; and does further 11 extend its humble and sincere condolences and fond remembrances of Guam's brave hero to Joe's family on his sixtieth (60th) birthdate; and be it 12 13 further
