16 Government Development Foundation; and

17         **WHEREAS**, Dr. Carlos is an accomplished author, has delivered a  
18 number of speeches, and has received numerous awards for her work in  
19 the field of Political Science; and

20         **WHEREAS**, as the inaugural guest lecturer, Dr. Carlos will deliver a  
21 lecture entitled, "U.S. Strategic Policy in the Asia Pacific: A Philippine  
22 Perspective" at the University of Guam; and

1           **WHEREAS**, Dr. Carlos will also deliver a speech to University of the  
2 Philippine alumni entitled, “Challenges of Democratic Deficits in Republic  
3 of the Philippines”, providing insight to the upcoming Presidential election  
4 in the Philippines; and

6 local elected officials, business and government leaders, and fellow  
7 University of the Philippine Alumni during the course of her visit to Guam;

13 be it further


14           **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Legislative Secretary
