1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***
2 ***MINA'TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS, Guam functions and succeeds as a result of the hard work of all**
4 **our working class heroes that serve our island everyday as workers, as parents, as**
5 **children, as friends, and as active citizens in our democracy; and**

1 **WHEREAS**, Guam’s working class heroes have long been the forgotten
2 backbone of our island, and they should be recognized for their commitment and
3 loyalty in serving the community; and

4 **WHEREAS**, there would be no tourism industry without hotel workers, no
5 schools without education professionals, no healthcare without nurses, no stores
6 without clerks, no phones without lines people, no clean streets without solid waste
7 professionals, no safe beaches and pools without lifeguards and park rangers, no
8 safety and protection without police officers and firefighters, no restaurants without
9 servers or cooks, no balanced books without accountants, no clean water without
10 water workers, no clean and maintained schools and buildings without custodians and
11 maintenance workers, and no children at school without bus drivers. Guam thrives
12 thanks to our working class heroes; and

13 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Corazon Mucho has dedicated over thirty (30) years to the
14 Department of Education as an elementary school teacher, educating our children with
15 the knowledge and skills to succeed in life; and

16 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Corazon Mucho is one of the longest standing, active
17 members of GFT Guam’s Local Union as the Treasurer, Secretary, and GFT
18 Representative for the Board of Educators, fighting for stronger labor laws and
19 improving the quality of life for working families; and

20 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Corazon Mucho has been involved in the growth and
21 accomplishments of the Filipino community as the president of the Filipino
22 Educator’s Association, as the treasurer of the Iloilo International Association, and as
23 a member of the Filipino Community of Guam; and

24 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Corazon Mucho has been committed to serving her church as
25 a Sunday School teacher, spreading the teachings of her faith to young children in
26 hopes of helping and encouraging them to uphold the values and beliefs of her
27 religion; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Corazon Mucho has exemplified the characteristics of a
2 working class hero dedicated to serving our island, not only in her capacity as an
3 educator and as a union officer, but also in her capacity as an enthusiastic member of
4 the Filipino community and her church community; now, therefore, be it


5 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trenta Na Liheslaturan*
