WHEREAS, Guam functions and succeeds as a result of the hard work of all our working class heroes that serve our island everyday as workers, as parents, as children, as friends, and as active citizens in our democracy; and

WHEREAS, Guam's working class heroes have long been the forgotten backbone of our island, and they should be recognized for their commitment and loyalty in serving the community; and

WHEREAS, there would be no tourism industry without hotel workers, no schools without education professionals, no healthcare without nurses, no stores without clerks, no phones without lines people, no clean streets without solid waste professionals, no safe beaches and pools without lifeguards and park rangers, no safety and protection without police officers and firefighters, no restaurants without servers or cooks, no balanced books without accountants, no clean water without water workers, no clean and maintained schools and buildings without custodians and maintenance workers, and no children at school without bus drivers. Guam thrives thanks to our working class heroes; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Raymond Guerrero has served over ten (10) years in the private sector, inclusive of military and civilian work, contributing valuable knowledge and skills to Guam's working economy; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Raymond Guerrero worked for No Ka Oi as a Sentricon 1 2 Specialist III, serving the company for five (5) years. Mr. Raymond Guerrero 3 also worked as a subcontractor for the Navy as a Material Handler, and for 4 the Air Force as a Demil Technician for three (3) years, handling explosives and heavy equipment. Mr. Raymond Guerrero is one of the few citizens on 5 island to hold a Marine Radio Operator license; and 6 7 WHEREAS, Mr. Raymond Guerrero is currently a lineman for GTA 8 Teleguam, one of Guam's communications providers, for over two (2) years. 9 Mr. Raymond Guerrero has shown interest in growth within the company by taking the company's "Learn and Earn" program and further expanding his 10 11 skills through an apprenticeship program at the Guam Community College for a Journeyman Certificate in the Lineman Installation and Repair field, 12 13 which will be completed in about three (3) years; and WHEREAS, Mr. Raymond Guerrero has dedicated close to fifteen (15) 14 15 years serving as a coach in the Guam Little League Baseball, the Guam Babe Ruth League, as well as the Adult Baseball League. Mr. Raymond Guerrero 16 had the privilege of coaching the Guam All-Star teams at tournaments in 17

WHEREAS, Mr. Raymond Guerrero actively participated in the

American Cancer Society's Relay for Life event as the Team Captain for Na Ko

Oi in 2002, 2003, 2004 and 2006, and has devoted some of his time serving as a
