18 *Chamorro* organizations, in the interpretation and translation of their music to
19 our *Chamorro* language; and


20 **WHEREAS,** it is the intent and desire of the United Recording Artists

6 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the
7 people of Guam, recognize and congratulate the United Recording Artists

10 of festivities and activities; and does extend *Un Dångkulo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse* to
11 them for their positive efforts toward the preservation of *Chamorro* Music,

18 (GVB); and to the Honorable Felix P. Camacho, *I Maga'lahren Guåhan*.


