1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**  
2 ***MINA'TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3           **WHEREAS,** Guam functions and succeeds as a result of the hard work  
4 of all our working class heroes that serve our island every day as workers, as  
5 parents, as children, as friends, and as active citizens in our democracy; and

6           **WHEREAS,** Guam's working class heroes have long been the forgotten  
7 backbone of our island, and they should be recognized for their commitment  
8 and loyalty in serving the community; and

9           **WHEREAS,** there would be no tourism industry without hotel workers,  
10 no schools without education professionals, no healthcare without nurses, no  
11 stores without clerks, no phones without lines people, no clean streets without  
12 solid waste professionals, no safe beaches and pools without lifeguards and  
13 park rangers, no safety and protection without police officers and firefighters,  
14 no restaurants without servers or cooks, no balanced books without  
15 accountants, no clean water without water workers, no clean and maintained  
16 schools and buildings without custodians and maintenance workers, and no  
17 children at school without bus drivers. Guam thrives thanks to our working  
18 class heroes; and

19           **WHEREAS,** Ms. Antonia Villagomez worked as a Cooking Assistant at  
20 Bishop Baumgartner Memorial School for four (4) years, preparing and  
21 cooking breakfast and lunch meals for our children, and ensuring they were  
22 well fed with proper, nutritious food; and

1           **WHEREAS**, Ms. Antonia Villagomez has been serving our children for  
2 twenty-one (21) years in Guam’s public schools, including C.L. Taitano  
3 Elementary School, Chalan Pago-Ordot Elementary School, and is currently at  
4 H.B. Price Elementary School, working as a Cooking Assistant, preparing and  
5 cooking breakfast and lunch meals; and

6           **WHEREAS**, in her spare time, Ms. Antonia Villagomez has been a  
7 member of the Guam Sunshine Lion’s Club for over a year now, helping the  
8 community with various projects, and making a positive impact for our  
9 island; and


10           **WHEREAS**, Ms. Antonia Villagomez has been working hard in her job  
11 to financially support six (6) children as a single mother and still making the  
12 time to nurture and raise them to be good citizens; and

13           **WHEREAS**, Ms. Antonia Villagomez’s dedication and commitment to  
14 serving meals for our children at Guam school’s for over twenty (20) years,  
15 while having the ability to be a supportive, single mother for her children,  
16 shows tremendous determination and strength; now, therefore, be it

17           **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina’Trenta Na*  
18 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the  
19 people of Guam, recognize Antonia Villagomez, one of Guam’s working class  
20 heroes, for her hard work and dedication, not just to her job, but to all the people of  
21 Guam; and does extend *Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu’os Ma’åse’* to her for her outstanding  
22 citizenship and accomplishments; and be it further
