Leon Guerrero joined the U.S. Army and was an active member of the 36th Military Police from 1980 to 1982; and 9 10 WHEREAS, on August 25, 1980, Daniel T. Leon Guerrero began his Government of Guam career service with the Department of Public Safety, 11 Fire Operations Bureau; and 12 WHEREAS, Daniel T. Leon Guerrero was transferred to the Guam Fire 13 Department on October 25, 1985, upon its creation; and 14 WHEREAS, Firefighter I Leon Guerrero was awarded Firefighter of the 15 Quarter (January - March 1988), and received a Meritorious Service Salary 16 Award for station beautification projects, while assigned at the Dededo Fire 17 Station (Station 4); and 18 WHEREAS, Firefighter I Leon Guerrero dedicated his personal time, 19

- of water while operating the pump or the nozzle; and

- 16 accomplishments provided costs savings to the Guam Fire Department, while
- 17 he displayed his loyalty, efficiency, dedication and competency above his
