1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**  
2 ***MINA'TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3           **WHEREAS**, Daniel Taitingfong Leon Guerrero was born on March 19,  
4 1956, in *Tamuning*. His parents are the late Juan Cruz Leon Guerrero and Ana  
5 Taitingfong Leon Guerrero; and

6           **WHEREAS**, Daniel T. Leon Guerrero is the proud father of a daughter,  
7 Brianne T. Leon Guerrero, and a son, Joshua P. Leon Guerrero; and

8           **WHEREAS**, in 1976, Daniel T. Leon Guerrero joined the U.S. Army and  
9 was an active member of the 36<sup>th</sup> Military Police from 1980 to 1982; and

10          **WHEREAS**, on August 25, 1980, Daniel T. Leon Guerrero began his  
11 Government of Guam career service with the Department of Public Safety,  
12 Fire Operations Bureau; and

13          **WHEREAS**, Daniel T. Leon Guerrero was transferred to the Guam Fire  
14 Department on October 25, 1985, upon its creation; and

15          **WHEREAS**, Firefighter I Leon Guerrero was awarded Firefighter of the  
16 Quarter (January - March 1988), and received a Meritorious Service Salary  
17 Award for station beautification projects, while assigned at the Dededo Fire  
18 Station (Station 4); and

19          **WHEREAS**, Firefighter I Leon Guerrero dedicated his personal time,  
20 effort and resources, and donated his personal funds, to beautify the fire

1 station for all crew members to enjoy, and to become compliant with  
2 Department General Orders, all at no cost to the Department; and

3       **WHEREAS**, from October 1, 1991, until his retirement, Firefighter I Leon  
4 Guerrero held the Fire Services Specialist position, and his various  
5 assignments included Fire Suppression; Fire Dispatch; Logistics and Supply;  
6 and EMS; and

7       **WHEREAS**, some of his projects included making homemade lockers  
8 and a coat rack to hang turn out gears; also, he established a filing system for  
9 Fire Station records, and he volunteered to exchange regular days off in lieu of  
10 overtime work; and

11       **WHEREAS**, when out on the field responding on the fire truck, FFI  
12 Leon Guerrero has displayed his professionalism by applying measures and  
13 methods to preserve the fire scene, and at the same time, conserve the usage  
14 of water while operating the pump or the nozzle; and


15       **WHEREAS**, all of Firefighter I Leon Guerrero's contributions and  
16 accomplishments provided costs savings to the Guam Fire Department, while  
17 he displayed his loyalty, efficiency, dedication and competency above his  
18 peers; now, therefore, be it

3 *Ma'åse'* and Best Wishes to him on his future endeavors; and be it further


4 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on


