WHEREAS, those students visited the Mt. Alifan battlefield unit of the War in the Pacific National Park in order to better understand the horrors of war and its effects on both the soldiers who fought it and the innocent civilians caught in its wake; and

WHEREAS, these visiting students reached out to the students of Southern High School in a student exchange program to foster understanding, peace, and fellowship; and

WHEREAS, it is hoped that this will become an annual trip, and that the tribute paid by these high school students will shine as an example that will encourage other students and organizations from Japan to make similar trips; and

WHEREAS, U.S. Explore & Study, Inc., has been instrumental in trying to heal the wounds of World War II and tensions over the war between the people of Japan, Guam, and the United States, and has held ceremonies and tributes in the past years with that noble aim; and

**WHEREAS**, the *U.S. Explore & Study, Inc.*, along with its president, Mr. Kensuke Haga, have worked extremely hard to move towards these goals and
