Relative to recognizing and commending the Judiciary of Guam for their support of children in need; and further urging the people of Guam to join in the national effort to raise awareness about the importance of adoption in honor of "National Adoption Day" on Saturday, November 21, 2009.

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN 2 GUÅHAN: WHEREAS, the people of Guam recognize the importance of providing
 permanent, safe and loving families for all children, including finding safe
 and loving families through adoption; and

WHEREAS, nearly one hundred thirty thousand (130,000) children are
currently in our country's foster care system waiting to be adopted, including
one hundred forty-one (141) children in the foster care system of Guam; and

WHEREAS, in Guam there are eighteen (18) licensed family foster
homes and three (3) group homes, and there are four (4) foster children in offisland placements or in residential treatment; and

10 WHEREAS, children in the foster care system need the nurturing 11 stability that placement with a loving family in a permanent adoptive home 12 can bring; and

WHEREAS, these children, who range in age from one (1) to seventeen
(17) years are anxiously awaiting acceptance and to become the newest
member of a loving family; and

WHEREAS, children in foster care in Guam are provided with some
form of permanency placement through adoption, guardianship or long term
foster care; and

WHEREAS, nearly sixty (60) adoption cases are filed and completed in
the Superior Court of Guam annually, providing homes for many needful
children; and

WHEREAS, other children in the foster care system are actively going
 through the system for eventual direction in their cases which, for some,
 could also include reunification with their families; and

WHEREAS, in Guam, most of our children end up in permanency
placements with relatives, to remain in long term foster care status, and with
their biological parents usually remaining in close and supervised contact at
the discretion of caregivers; and

8 WHEREAS, to help these children find permanent, nurturing families, 9 the courts of Guam will open their doors on "National Adoption Day", 10 Saturday, November 21, 2009, to finalize the adoptions of local children and 11 join other organizations to celebrate all adoptions; and

WHEREAS, this effort in Guam, along with similar celebrations in all fifty (50) states, the District of Columbia and United States insular areas, will offer children the chance to live with stable and loving families and encourage other dedicated individuals to make a powerful difference in the lives of children through adoption; now, therefore, be it

17 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina' Trenta Na Liheslaturan Guahan*, does hereby on 18 behalf of the people of Guam, recognize and commend the Judiciary of Guam 19 for their support of children in need; and does further urge the people of 20 Guam to join in the national effort to raise awareness about the importance of 21 adoption in honor of "National Adoption Day" on Saturday, November 21, 22 2009; and be it further 1 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Legislative Secretary 2 attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be thereafter 3 transmitted to the Honorable Robert J. Torres, Chief Justice, Supreme Court of 4 Guam; to the Honorable Alberto C. Lamorena III, Presiding Judge Superior 5 Court of Guam; and to the Honorable Felix P. Camacho, *I Maga'lahen Guåhan*.
