3 **WHEREAS**, Rosita P. San Nicolas was born on September 30, 1951, in

18 work with the government of Guam as an Interviewing Clerk II at the Guam
19 Memorial Hospital; and

20 **WHEREAS**, on June 8, 1970, Rosita P. San Nicolas began employment
21 with the District Court of Guam as a Temporary Clerical Assistant for an
22 indefinite term; and

1 **WHEREAS**, in December 1973, she was promoted to Deputy Clerk and
2 performed duties as Secretary to the Clerk, Court Reporter Monitor,
3 Courtroom Deputy Clerk, Telephone Coordinator, Civil Docket Clerk,
4 Criminal Docket Clerk, and also performed financial duties, including cashier
5 responsibility; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Rosita P. San Nicolas was promoted to Courtroom Deputy
7 on June 4, 1990, and then was promoted to Chief Deputy Clerk on September
8 16, 1991; and

20 endeavors; and be it further


21 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Legislative Secretary
