3 **WHEREAS**, in 1975, Mr. Cong Lin Wu received a Bachelor of Arts
4 degree in English, Foreign Language Department, from Fudan University;
5 from 1976 to 1986, he worked with the Chinese-Polish Shipping Company;
6 and from 1987 to 1991, he worked with the China Merchant's Company,
7 Guam; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Wu is a person of exceptional ability and vision; he
9 successfully started an international trade company in 1991, becoming the
10 President of JJQ International Trading Company, Ltd., Guam, and is a former
11 President of the Guam Chinese Association; and

12 **WHEREAS**, in addition to his accomplishments in the business realm,
13 he has also dedicated his time to actively help build stronger relations
14 between China, the country of his birth, and Guam, the place he calls home;
15 and

16 **WHEREAS**, under Mr. Wu's leadership as President of the Guam
17 Chinese Association, the organization received numerous Chinese leaders and
18 dignitaries, such as Consul Generals, ambassadors, sailors from the Chinese
19 Naval Fleet, representatives, and leaders from CAIFC who visited Guam; and

20 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Wu worked with the Chinese Chamber of Commerce
21 of Guam, the U.S. Coast Guard, the Chinese Consulate, and the Guam Chinese
22 Association, in providing assistance, support and spiritual comfort to those

1 affected by numerous disasters, to include the tragically sunken ship
2 “Haitong 7”, and the Sichuan earthquake which struck in May 2008, and
3 which received One Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$120,000.00) from
4 the GCA; and

5 **WHEREAS**, as President of the Guam Chinese Association, Mr. Wu also
6 organized numerous variety shows and cultural performances to promote the
7 beauty of the Chinese culture, and to help build long-lasting friendships
8 between the Chinese people and the people of Guam; and


9 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Wu has kind-heartedly contributed to Guam’s
