18 Department of Public Health and Social Services was as a General Helper,
19 until she was assigned as Social Services Aide I on October 24, 1976; and

21 Assistance Payment Worker I. She was then promoted to Assistance Payment

22 Worker II on August 11, 1980, and Assistance Payment Worker III
23 (Reclassified to Eligibility Specialist Supervisor) on October 26, 1982; and

25 and returned as Public Welfare Investigator in February 1991; and
