Relative to memorializing and acknowledging the accomplishments of the late Honorable Cristobal Camacho Dueñas, the first *Chamorro* appointed to a Federal Court Bench; to expressing *Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse* to him for his great contributions to the people of Guam; and to offering sincere condolences to his family.

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I* 2 *MINA'TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:

3 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Cristobal C. Dueñas was born on 4 September 12, 1920, in *Hagatña*. His parents are †Jose C. Dueñas and 5 †Concepcion C. Dueñas; and

6 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Cristobal C. Dueñas attended the
7 Aquinas College in Grand Rapids, Michigan, and graduated in 1952 from the
8 University of Michigan Law School; and

9 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Cristobal C. Dueñas was admitted to the
10 Guam Bar Association in 1953, and worked as an assistant to the Attorney
11 General until 1957; and

WHEREAS, the late Honorable Cristobal C. Dueñas was appointed to
serve as Director of the Department of Land Management in 1957; and

WHEREAS, the late Honorable Cristobal C. Dueñas then served as a
Judge for the Island Court of Guam, from 1960 to 1969; and

WHEREAS, on December 11, 1969, the late Honorable Cristobal C.
Dueñas was appointed by President Richard Nixon to serve as Judge of the
District Court of Guam, the first *Chamorro* in Guam's history to be appointed
to a Federal Court Bench; and

WHEREAS, as Judge of the District Court, the Honorable Cristobal C.
Dueñas presided over several prominent cases, including the corruption trial
of former Governor Ricardo J. Bordallo; the anti-trust lawsuit filed against the

Guam International Airport Authority and Duty Free Shoppers Ltd.; and a
 suit filed by the hospital employees against the Guam Memorial Hospital; and

3 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Cristobal C. Dueñas was re-appointed 4 by President Jimmy Carter to continue serving as Judge of the District Court 5 of Guam, and he was known in the legal community as a man who knew how 6 to apply the law, and who was a fair, pious and lovable gentleman; and

WHEREAS, in January 1988, the Ninth Circuit Court awarded the
senior status to the late Honorable Cristobal C. Dueñas; and

9 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Cristobal C. Dueñas also was a civic-10 minded individual, who helped the 1st Council Knights of Columbus of Guam 11 in 1968; he was the first Grand Knight Charter Faithful Navigator of the 12 Knights of Columbus; and was a former President of the St. Vincent de Paul 13 Society of Guam, from the late 1950s to early 1960s; and

WHEREAS, in 1996, the late Honorable Cristobal C. Dueñas was a
recipient of the Knight of the Order of St. Silvestre, and Knight of the Order of
St. Gregory by Pope John Paul II, one of the highest honors conferred by the
Catholic Church; and

WHEREAS, the late Honorable Cristobal C. Dueñas retired on January
31, 1991, and was called to his eternal rest on February 14, 2010; and

20 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Cristobal C. Dueñas will be dearly 21 missed by his wife, Juanita Calvo Dueñas; his children: Christopher J.C. and 22 Ramona Dueñas; Vincent C. Dueñas; Zerlina D. and Ivan Shiroma; Joanna C. Dueñas and Susan L. Geersen; Ricardo C. Dueñas; David C. and Monique
 Williams – Dueñas; his nine (9) grandchildren; two (2) great-grand children;
 and his brother, sisters, family and friends; now, therefore, be it
