3           **WHEREAS,** a high school education is the foundation on which the  
4 future generation is built; and

5           **WHEREAS,** in 1833, the Blessed Mother Theresa of Jesus Gerhardinger  
6 of Bavaria, Germany, founded the order of the School Sisters of Notre Dame  
7 (SSND); and

8           **WHEREAS,** the mission of the School Sisters of Notre Dame is to  
9 proclaim the good news and directing their entire lives toward that oneness  
10 for which Jesus Christ was sent; and

11           **WHEREAS,** the ministry of the School Sisters of Notre Dame is directed  
12 toward education and enabling persons to reach the fullness of their potential  
13 as individuals created in God's image; and

14           **WHEREAS,** committed to this goal, the School Sisters of Notre Dame  
15 established Notre Dame High School on Guam in 1968; and

16           **WHEREAS,** Notre Dame High School, located in the southern village of  
17 *Talofoto*, offered young women a Roman Catholic education not only in  
18 academics but also emphasizing spiritual, moral, and social values; and

19           **WHEREAS,** in 1977, senior students Ms. Louise Baza and Ms. Dorothy  
20 Perez Harris collaborated in composing the school's alma mater; and

1           **WHEREAS**, in 1995, Notre Dame High School opened its doors to  
2 young men becoming Guam’s first and only Roman Catholic co-educational  
3 high school; and

4           **WHEREAS**, today, Notre Dame High School, has an average enrollment  
5 of three hundred thirty-five (335) students, and forty (40) faculty and staff  
6 members teaching in the fields of Theology, Mathematics, Science, Social  
7 Science, Fine Arts, Foreign Language, Physical Education and English; and

8           **WHEREAS**, Notre Dame High School continues to promote tolerance  
9 and the value of the environment, and to instill in its students a deeper  
10 understanding of their faith and their role in the world as Catholic  
11 Christians;to now, therefore, be it


12           **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina’Trenta Na*
