WHEREAS, in 1995, Notre Dame High School opened its doors to
 young men becoming Guam's first and only Roman Catholic co-educational
 high school; and

WHEREAS, today, Notre Dame High School, has an average enrollment
of three hundred thirty-five (335) students, and forty (40) faculty and staff
members teaching in the fields of Theology, Mathematics, Science, Social
Science, Fine Arts, Foreign Language, Physical Education and English; and
