- 15 a half million dollars; and
- 16 WHEREAS, planning for the Center was a collaborative effort,
- 17 including meetings with the Guam Comprehensive Cancer Coalition, the
- 18 American Cancer Society, the University of Guam, the Guam Memorial
- 19 Hospital, and others; and
- WHEREAS, a number of quality healthcare providers are now residents
- 21 of Guam and part of the Center's Cancer Team, including Dr. Theresa
