WHEREAS, Dr. James J. Taylor retires from the government of Guam as
an Associate Professor of Finance at the University of Guam (UOG) in *Mangilao*; and

6 WHEREAS, Dr. Taylor served as an elected Trustee, and Secretary of
7 the Government of Guam Retirement Fund Board of Trustees, from April 2004
8 to June 2009; and

9 WHEREAS, Dr. Taylor has also served as the Treasurer of the 10 University of Guam Faculty Union, and as a member of both the University of 11 Guam Salary Review Committee, and the UOG Graduate Curriculum Review 12 Committee; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Taylor's educational credentials include a Ph.D. in Curriculum, Instruction, and Administration from the University of Nebraska at Lincoln; an M.B.A. in Financial Management from Saint Louis University in 16 1972; a Masters in Education and Certification as a Teacher, as well as a Superintendent for (K-14) in 1966; and a B.A. in History and Philosophy from 0blate College of the Southwest; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Taylor completed the Certificate of Advanced Study
(C.A.S.) from Harvard University Graduate School of Education (1976-1977),
and he was chosen to teach *Accounting and Budget Control in Higher Education*at Harvard's Graduate School of Education; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Taylor's teaching experience includes teaching
 numerous courses at the University of Guam, the Guam Community College,
 the Harvard University Graduate School of Education, and at the Althoff
 High School in Belleville, Illinois; and

5 WHEREAS, at UOG, Dr. Taylor developed syllabi for and taught eight 6 (8) different courses, as well as the Financial Management Workbook, that is 7 being used in lieu of a text in the BA620 course; and

8 WHEREAS, Dr. Taylor served as the Vice President for Business and 9 Finance at the Guam Community College, and as a Trustee of the Guam 10 Community College Foundation Board; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Taylor's business background includes work with the
Taylor Management Group, American Management Systems, West Virginia
University System, and Chief Business Officers of the Pacific; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Taylor is a founder and treasurer of KPRG-FM Guam
Public Radio, and he was instrumental in successfully bringing National
Public Radio to Guam, utilizing the first ever double satellite hop; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Taylor has made numerous presentations, has authored
several publications, and has hosted, organized, and attended many
conferences and workshops; and

20 WHEREAS, Dr. Taylor has been involved with many professional 21 organizations, including: member of the Board of Governors, Guam 22 Community College Foundation; the National Association of College and

University Business Officers; Harvard Club at the National Press Club, 1 2 Washington, D.C.; Founding Member, Chief Business Officers of the Pacific; he is one(1) of the three (3) initial founders of the Guam Educational Radio 3 4 Foundation - KPRG-FM, Public Radio for Guam; Fiscal and Strategic Technical Assistance Program (FASTAP) of the College Fund / UNCF, Consultant; 5 member of the Advisory Commission on Special Education, Arlington, 6 7 Virginia School District; and the Saint Louis Area High School Film Makers 8 Festival - Founder and Producer of the first three (3) festivals; and

9 WHEREAS, Dr. Taylor's honors and awards include: the Administrator of the Year (Academic Year 2000-2001); the Award for Support of the Student 10 Association, from the Student Government Association, Guam Community 11 College (Academic Years 1995-1996 and 1997-1998); the Guam Public Radio 12 13 Foundation Distinguished Service Award for Support of Guam Public Radio; from March 2001 to the present he was named to the Who's Who in America (1996-14 15 present, 50th through present editions); the Who's Who in the World (1994present, 12th through present editions); he was honored by the Twenty-Second 16 17 (22nd) Guam Legislature for his achievements; and in 1994, he was named as a Charter Lifetime Member of Friends of Public Radio, for those individuals 18 instrumental in bringing public radio to Guam; now, therefore, be it 19
