5           **WHEREAS**, in June of 1979, Elvira Ayson Dorian came to Guam to  
6 serve its people as an educator; and

7           **WHEREAS**, in 1985, Mrs. Dorian became an active faculty member of  
8 the Santa Barbara Catholic School in *Dededo*; and

9           **WHEREAS**, four (4) years later, Mrs. Dorian joined the D.L. Perez  
10 Elementary School family, and has remained with the school for twenty-one  
11 (21) years; and

12           **WHEREAS**, she was a member of the Manila Public School Teachers  
13 Association; and

14           **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Dorian also serves as a teacher with the Our Lady of  
15 Lourdes CCD program, and is a member of the choir at the Parish's Saturday  
16 evening Mass service; and

17           **WHEREAS**, throughout her career, she has touched and inspired the  
18 lives of countless schoolchildren and colleagues; and

19           **WHEREAS**, after twenty-five (25) years of educating the island's people,  
20 Mrs. Dorian will retire; now, therefore, be it

21           **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trenta Na*  
22 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the

1 people of Guam, commend Elvira Ayson Dorian for her twenty-five (25) years  
2 of service to the people of Guam; does congratulate her and wish her well on  
3 her retirement; and does further extend *Un Dangkulo Na Si Yu'os Ma'ase'* to  
4 her for her dedication to educating the community; and be it further
