3 WHEREAS, Captain Hill C. Leon Guerrero was born in Guam, on
4 January 14, 1969; and

5 WHEREAS, Captain Leon Guerrero is married to the former Maria Liza
6 C. Dalmacio, and they have two (2) beautiful children: Hill Junior and Brynn
7 Ellese; and

8 WHEREAS, after graduating from the University of Guam in June 1991, 9 Captain Leon Guerrero was commissioned as a Second Lieutenant of Field 10 Artillery; and

WHEREAS, in 1993, Captain Leon Guerrero completed the Field
Artillery Officer Basic Course and was assigned to the 3rd Battalion, 7th Field
Artillery "Never Broken" at Schofield Barracks, 25th Infantry Division (Light), *Hawaii*, where he served as a Forward Observer for the 4th Battalion, 87th
Infantry Brigade, and later as a Fire Direction Officer, Platoon Leader and
Target Analyst for the 1st Battalion, 8th Field Artillery "Automatic"; and

WHEREAS, in June 1996, Captain Leon Guerrero transitioned from
Active Duty to the Individual Ready Reserves; and

WHEREAS, shortly thereafter, Captain Leon Guerrero started his
 civilian career in law enforcement as a Probation Officer at the Superior Court
 of Guam; and

WHEREAS, in February 2003, Captain Leon Guerrero transitioned from
 the Individual Ready Reserves to the U.S. Army Reserves, and was assigned
 to the 1101st GSU DET-1, Guam, where he served as the Transportation
 Section Chief; and

5 WHEREAS, in August 2005, he was reassigned to the 80th Division (IT) 6 in Richmond, Virginia and deployed to Baghdad, Iraq, where he served as the 7 Assistant Team Chief and Team Chief for the 1st Battalion, 3rd Public Order 8 Brigade Special Police Transition Team, and Assistant Team Chief for 3rd 9 Battalion, 8th Brigade, 2nd National Police Division Special Police Transition 10 Team; and

11 WHEREAS, on August 3, 2006, Captain Leon Guerrero was released 12 from Active Duty and reassigned to the 1101st GSU DET-1 Guam, where he 13 served as the Operations Officer; and

WHEREAS, in June 2007, Captain Leon Guerrero assumed duties as the
Operations Officer for the 9th Theatre Support Group (Prov.), Guam, and on
October 1, 2007, he was mobilized to *Hawaii* and assumed command of an
active duty unit, Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, United States
Army Garrison- *Hawaii*, where he served from November 5, 2007 to October
30, 2008; and

WHEREAS, Captain Leon Guerrero was reassigned to the 322nd Civil
 Affairs Brigade, and served as a member of the Civil Affairs Team on Guam in
 January 2009; and

WHEREAS, Captain Leon Guerrero's awards and decorations include:
the Bronze Star Medal; the Meritorious Service Medal; the Army
Commendation Medal; the Army Achievement Medal; the National Defense
Service Medal (2nd Award); the Iraq Campaign Medal; the Global War on
Terrorism Service Medal; the Army Service Ribbon (2nd Award); the Armed
Forces Reserve Medal (with M-Device); the Combat Action Badge; and the Air
Assault Badge; now, therefore, be it
