1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN**

3 **WHEREAS**, on October 8, 2010, the people of Taiwan will celebrate the
4 Ninety-ninth (99th) “Double-Tenth National Day” of the Republic of China
5 (Taiwan), a day that commemorates the triumph over the Ching Dynasty, and
6 the beginning of the Republic of China under the leadership of Dr. Sun Yat-
7 Sen; and

8 **WHEREAS**, since 1973, the people of Guam have shared a special Sister-
9 City bond with the people of Taipei City that has benefited Guam and Taiwan
10 through its cultural exchanges and economic investments; and

11 **WHEREAS**, this strong Sister-City relationship, that has lasted for more
12 than three (3) decades, has translated into millions of dollars in investments
13 on the Island of Guam, which the people of Guam are grateful for; and

14 **WHEREAS**, more than thirty-two thousand (32,000) visitors from
15 Taiwan have come to visit the island of Guam this year, fostering the growth
16 of tourism, which is one of Guam’s primary industries; and

17 **WHEREAS**, the Chinese Community of Guam, including the United
18 Chinese Association of Guam, the Chinese Chamber of Commerce of Guam,
19 the Confucius Society of Guam, and the Chinese Ladies Association of Guam,
20 continue to be at the forefront of various worthwhile community projects
21 throughout Guam; and its people have embraced the Chinese culture and are

1 eternally grateful for the generosity the Chinese Community of Guam has
2 extended to our people; and

3 **WHEREAS**, the people of Guam, both from the government and the
4 private sectors, recognize the continued efforts, determination, commitments
5 and labor that the various Chinese organizations contribute to the Island of
6 Guam and its residents; now, therefore, be it

7 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Trenta Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on
8 behalf of the people of Guam, congratulate the Republic of China (Taiwan) on
9 the occasion of the Ninety-ninth (99th) "Double-Tenth National Day"; and
10 does further recognize and commend the Chinese Community of Guam for
11 their invaluable contributions to the Island of Guam, and does extend *Un*
12 *Dangkulo Na Si Yu'os Ma'ase* to them for their efforts in fostering a closer
13 relationship with the people of Guam; and be it further

22 Office in Guam; to Mr. Joseph Hsu, President of the United Chinese
