WHEREAS, Mr. Grossbichler attended school in Austria, where he studied as an apprentice in the butchery and chef program in 1980, and upon completion he worked his way up to the position of Executive Chef in 1991; and he has since held this position at the Hyatt Regency Hotels in numerous countries, such as Korea, India, Malaysia, and Guam; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Grossbichler has been an active participant in the ProStart Program since its beginnings at the Guam Community College in 2004, serving as a mentor for over fifty (50) students in the Program. ProStart is a national program geared to students interested in pursuing careers in culinary arts and foodservice management, by acquiring the knowledge and skills through classroom study, mentored work experiences, and participation in local and national competitions; and

WHEREAS, the overall enrollment rate for the ProStart Program ranks second among the popular courses chosen by Guam's public school students, with an enrollment totaling three hundred seventy-eight (378) students; with George Washington High School leading the ranks with one hundred twenty-five (125) students; Simon Sanchez High School with ninety-six (96) students;

1 John F. Kennedy High School with one hundred six (106) students; and

2 Southern High School with seventy-one (71) enrollees in the program; and

WHEREAS, in 2009, the ProStart students from George Washington
High School competed in the National Restaurant Association's ProStart
Invitational, and placed Fourth (4th) nationally, proving the high quality of the

6 overall performance of Guam's ProStart students; and

WHEREAS, Chef Grossbichler, who is responsible for more than ten (10) apprentices from the Guam Community College's Culinary Arts Program, has helped students learn the culinary arts through formal on-the-job training, in addition to related classroom instruction, which has been instrumental to the success of the students in the program through the building of character, confidence, and empowerment, leading to a career in the culinary arts; additionally, students have developed a deep appreciation of his valued expertise of the business, and inherently have established relationships beneficial for their professional development and endeavors; now, therefore, be it
