Relative to commending and congratulating PBS Guam on its Fortieth (40th) Anniversary of providing public television to Guam.

1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I MINA'***
2 ***TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:**
3 **WHEREAS, President Lyndon B. Johnson declared, upon the signing**
4 **of the Public Broadcasting Act of 1967, "We in America have an appetite**

1 for excellence, too. While we work every day to produce new goods and to
2 create new wealth, we want most of all to enrich man's spirit;" and

3 **WHEREAS**, to this end, the Corporation for Public Broadcasting was
4 created, under which was established the Guam Educational
5 Telecommunications Commission, charged with assessing the value of
6 educational television and radio, and functioning as the medium for the
7 transmission thereof, since 1970; and

8 **WHEREAS**, *I Mina' Dosse Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* created the public,
9 nonprofit Guam Educational Telecommunications Corporation to operate
10 PBS Guam, and to ensure Guam's participation and parallel development
11 in the advancement of satellite technology and international
12 communications; and

13 **WHEREAS**, since the Corporation's creation in 1975, the leadership
14 of the seven (7) member Board of Trustees has seen the station through
15 remarkable innovations and has kept apace with the rest of the world in
16 meeting rapid technological advancements; and

17 **WHEREAS**, such advancements have empowered PBS Guam with
18 the capability to expand its services and transmissions to include
19 broadcasts of live events at remote locations and the production of original
20 local programming; and

21 **WHEREAS**, in addition to the Award Winning National
22 Programming, PBS Guam has produced the original local children's

1 weekly, *Clubhouse 12*; the weekly local current events talk-show, *På'gu*; and
2 the weekly local nature documentary, "Off Shore Diaries"; and

3 **WHEREAS**, the administration, film, and production offices staff of
4 PBS Guam continue to fulfill the duties entrusted to them forty (40) years
5 ago by delivering quality educational programming that is relevant to the
6 local community, and which bonds our people through the shared
7 experience of living on Guam; now, therefore, be it

8 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trenta Na*
9 *Lihselaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Lihselaturan Guåhan* and the
10 people of Guam, commend and congratulate PBS Guam and the Guam
11 Educational Telecommunications Corporation for forty (40) years of
12 excellence in providing public television to the people of Guam; and be it
13 further

14 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee
15 on Rules certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof,
16 and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to Dr. Sam Mabini,
17 General Manager, PBS Guam; and to the Honorable Felix P. Camacho, *I*
18 *Maga'lahaen Guåhan*.


