WHEREAS, the Torres family has participated in numerous cultural events, such as I Gupot Fanha'aniyan Pulan Chamoru (Chamorro Lunar Festivities); Gupot I Peskadot; Earth Day; and the Micronesian Island Fair. During the 1st and 2nd Annual Gupot Fanha'aniyan Pulan Chamoru, Tom and his family participated in the "Katupat Weaving Party", weaving hundreds of Katupats for the feast. In this event, each family member demonstrates and teaches participants how to weave the Katupat, and explains its cultural

WHEREAS, in addition to being a Master Weaver, Tom was also a cultural subsistence fisherman, and he always ensured that his family participated in every Gupot I Peskadot, which is sponsored by the Guam 1 Fishermen's Cooperative Association. At the request of the organizers, Tom

2 and his family assisted with the festival decorations, and they also weaved

hats for the many influential visitors, both local and from off-island, who

4 came to Guam to attend the fishery events; and

WHEREAS, Tom's woven coconut leaf hats have found their way around the world, and many visitors, whom he had given hats to, have kept in contact with Tom and his family and friends, and they still talk about the special hats they received to remember their visit to Guam; and

WHEREAS, Tom, a former employee of the Department of Parks and Recreation, will always be remembered for his hard work and commitment to service for the people of Guam, which later translated to his work as a Master Weaver. For his many invaluable contributions, the people of Guam recognize and honor Tom Torres for upholding his *Chamorro* beliefs and values, and for sharing it through his gift of cultural *Chamorro* weaving; now, therefore, be it
