13 Forces, and to those who continue to do so today; and

14 **WHEREAS,** the Guam Vet Center hosts, as part of its community
15 outreach effort, the Annual Guam Veterans' Creative Arts Showcase, an event
16 which celebrates the creative expression and talents of Guam Veterans; and


17 **WHEREAS,** the Annual Guam Veterans' Creative Arts Showcase helps
