1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**

3 **WHEREAS,** Chief Master Sergeant John S.N. Martinez is the devoted
4 husband of Florence Paulino Martinez, and the proud father of three (3)
5 children, all of whom have continued the family legacy of serving in the
6 U.S. Armed Forces: SSgt Lance Martinez, A1C Christina Martinez, and A1C
7 John Martinez; and

8 **WHEREAS,** Chief Martinez is the Command Chief Master Sergeant
9 of the Guam Air National Guard Headquarters, and works on behalf of the
10 Adjutant General of Guam; and

11 **WHEREAS,** Chief Martinez is the Guam Air National Guard Senior
12 Listed Advisor, and he is responsible for all affairs concerning the enlisted
13 personnel of the Guam Air National Guard; and

14 **WHEREAS,** in July 1982, Chief Martinez embarked on his military
15 career, enlisting as a traditional guardsman in the Guam Air National
16 Guard, and serving as an Engineering Assistance Trainee with the 254th
17 Civil Engineering Flight; and in March 1983, Chief Martinez completed the
18 Air Force Basic Military Training and the Engineering Assistance
19 Apprentice Course; and

20 **WHEREAS,** upon receiving his Bachelor of Arts Degree in
21 Psychology and Education from the University of Guam in 1984, Chief

1 Martinez subsequently retrained into the Training career field as the Unit
2 Training Manager in 1986; and

3 **WHEREAS**, in July 1989, Chief Martinez took an active duty position
4 for a period of four (4) years, serving as the Base Training Manager for the
5 254th Air Base Group; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Chief Martinez has held numerous positions in the
7 Military Personnel Flight prior to becoming the Recruiter for the Guam Air
8 National Guard in June 2000; and

9 **WHEREAS**, in June 2004, Chief Martinez was promoted, and served
10 as the first Personnel and Recruiting Superintendent for the 254th Air Base
11 Group; and in April 2006, Chief Martinez was selected to be the 4th
12 Command Chief for the Guam Air National Guard; and

13 **WHEREAS**, throughout his professional career, Chief Martinez has
14 accumulated many awards and decorations, to include: the Meritorious
15 Service Medal with oak leaf cluster; the Air Force Commendation Medal
16 with two (2) oak leaf clusters; the Air Force Achievement Medal; the Army
17 Achievement Medal; the Joint Meritorious Service Medal; the Air Reserve
18 Forces Meritorious Service Medal with one (1) silver and two (2) oak leaf
19 clusters; the Air Force Outstanding Unit Award; the National Defense
20 Service Medal; the Armed Forces Reserve Medal; the Air Force Longevity

1 Service Award Ribbon with one (1) silver leaf cluster; and the Air Force
2 Training Ribbon; now, therefore, be it

5 the people of Guam, recognize and congratulate Chief Master Sergeant John

9 further acknowledge Chief Martinez as an asset to our island community;
