8 Corey, Anne and Brad; and four (4) grandchildren: Grace, Marcus, Keeley and
9 Caelyn; and

10 **WHEREAS,** in 1968, Janet graduated *Magna Cum Laude* from Howard
11 Payne University, earning a Bachelor of Arts Degree; and in 1999, she
12 graduated from the University of Guam, earning a Masters of Education
13 Degree; and

14 **WHEREAS,** Janet Goldhorn's service in the field of education includes
15 her teaching experiences at public schools in Texas and South Dakota;
16 Watertown Business University; Simon Sanchez High School; Andersen
17 Elementary School, (DoDEA, Guam); McCool Middle School (DoDEA,

20 music, as she also teaches private lessons in piano, flute, and organ; and

13 flautist with the Guam Symphony since 2009; and




14 **WHEREAS**, in addition to her relentless contributions in promoting
