1           **WHEREAS**, Joseph L.G. Rios, Jr., is married to Sera Shinohara Rios, and  
2 they have four (4) wonderful children: Joseph, Jason, Nathan and Alana; and

11 and to the Honorable Felix P. Camacho, *I Maga'lahren Guåhan*.


