3 **WHEREAS**, Artemio B. Ilagan was born on January 1, 1955, and is the
4 son of Artemio M. and Carmelita B. Ilagan; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Artemio B. Ilagan is married to Kathleen Martinez Ilagan,
6 and they have three (3) wonderful children: Michael, Krystyna and Joseph;
7 and are also blessed with three (3) adorable grandchildren: Matthew, Elijah
8 and Andriana; and

9 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Ilagan began his government of Guam career with the
10 Department of Revenue & Taxation in August 1980, working as a Tax
11 Auditor. Over the years, he was promoted to several positions, including:
12 Supervisor of Examination Branch; Supervisor of Criminal Investigation
13 Branch; and Tax Enforcement Administrator. In 2002, Mr. Ilagan was
14 appointed to serve as the Director of Revenue & Taxation, a position of
15 prestige and honor. During his tenure as Director, he was a dedicated leader
16 who relentlessly aspired to improve the Department's operations and service
17 to the public.

18 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Artemio B. Ilagan had also served our country, and
19 retired in 2003 as a Tech Sergeant (E6), and he was a Non-Commissioned
20 Officer-in-Charge of his division, Information Management, in the U.S. Air
21 Force Reserve; and

2 civil duties, which includes serving as a Committee Member for Coast 360
3 Credit Union; serving as a member of the Young Men’s League of Guam; and
4 serving on the Finance Committee of his Parish, the Immaculate Heart of
5 Mary Church in *Toto*; and

6 **WHEREAS**, on December 31, 2010, Mr. Artemio B. Ilagan retires from
7 the Department of Revenue & Taxation, after thirty-six (36) years of dedicated
8 government service; and

9 **WHEREAS**, through his dedication and commitment to public service,
10 Mr. Ilagan has positively impacted and contributed to the efficiency of the
11 Department of Revenue & Taxation, where he will be truly missed, and his
12 colleagues and friends wish him the best on his well-deserved retirement;
13 now, therefore, be it

15 *Liheslaturan Guåhan*, does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the
