Relative to recognizing and commending Mr. Maximo Ronquillo, Jr., the members of the Guam Territorial Band, and all other collaborators of the Tumon Bay Music Festival for providing high caliber musical entertainment and friendly competition here on Guam.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I

- WHEREAS, the Tumon Bay Band Festival was founded in March 2005 by Mr. Maximo Ronquillo, Jr., the 8th Music Director of the Guam Territorial Band; and
- WHEREAS, with the assistance of Dr. Robert Halseth from California
 State University of Sacramento, and the University of Guam music professors,
 Dr. Randall Johnson, Dr. Stephen Bednarzyk and Dr. Cynthia Sanjnovsky, a
 three (3) day band festival was held and featured adjudicated performances
 by Guam's public, private and military school bands. At the conclusion of
 this festival, Harvest Christian Academy was honored as the Command
 Performance band for both the middle and high school divisions; and
- WHEREAS, the following year, in 2006, the festival grew to a five (5)
 day event; and then in 2007, the event was aptly renamed the "Tumon Bay
 Music Festival" due to the inclusion of a choral festival, a hand bell choir
 festival, and performances by rock and jazz ensembles over a nine (9) day
 period. Also during the 2007 festival, Mr. Randolph Stenson, from St. Mary's
 School in Tokyo, Japan, was invited to serve on the first choral and hand bell
 choir adjudication faculty; and
- WHEREAS, that same year, the Festival Sweepstakes Trophy was presented for the first time. The award was given to the ensemble with the

highest adjudicated score totals, regardless of category. The first winning
 group was the choral group, Magis; and

WHEREAS, in 2008, the Tumon Bay Music Festival was expanded even further, to become a regional event when two (2) school band programs from Saipan participated. Another first time participant was the first Festival Select Band, conducted by Mr. Atsushi Ozawa. The 2008 Festival also included a piano performance by Sydney-based Mr. Evgeny Ukhanov, who is originally from the Ukraine. Mr. Ukhanov's performance of Maestro Ronquillo's band arrangement of Shostakovich's *Piano Concerto No. 2* was the world premiere of any such arrangement. The 2008 festival also featured Mr. Stenson's arrangement of "Tumon Bay," a piece written by the late Captain Peter Siguenza, Sr. (USMC-Ret.). At the conclusion of the 2008 festival, the 2008 Sweepstakes Trophy was awarded to the Saipan Southern High School Manta Band; and

WHEREAS, the Tumon Bay Music Festival is a production of the Guam Territorial Band Society. Mr. Ronquillo's seventeen (17) years of experience as a clarinetist and band master with the Guam Territorial Band has allowed him the opportunity to travel the globe. The experience of performing music of the highest caliber, while making friends with other musicians from all over the world, inspired him to organize the Tumon Bay Music Festival. This festival is a collective gesture of thanks from Mr. Ronquillo and the musicians of the Guam Territorial Band to our supportive island community; and

WHEREAS, through music education, the Tumon Bay Music Festival 1 will be a vehicle to showcase the region's musical talents in an effort to foster 2 3 friendships throughout the world; now, therefore, be it 4 **RESOLVED,** that the Committee on Rules, of I Mina'Trenta Na 5 Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby, on behalf of I Liheslaturan Guåhan and the 6 people of Guam, recognize and commend Mr. Maximo Ronquillo, Jr., the members of the Guam Territorial Band, and all other collaborators of the 7 8 Tumon Bay Music Festival for providing high caliber musical entertainment 9 and friendly competition here on Guam; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules certify, and the Legislative Secretary attests to, the adoption hereof; and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to Mr. Maximo Ronquillo, Jr.; and to the Honorable Felix P. Camacho, *I Maga'lahen Guåhan*.
