11 examine the effects of militarism on safety in communities, the geopolitical

13 foreign bases in maintaining the U.S.'s efforts for global reach is pertinent to  
14 ensuring that Guam's military development does not negatively impact the  
15 lives of the people of Guam; now, therefore, be it
