BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

WHEREAS, the Committee on Economic Development, the Judiciary, and Health has oversight of the Guam Economic Development and Commerce Authority, which is the government agency responsible for the issuance, selling, and disposition of bonds. However, I Mina'Trenta Na Liheslaturan Guahån Otden Areklamento (Thirtieth Guam Legislature Standing Rules), dictates that bills of bonds of any nature shall be referred to a joint committee composed of the Committee on Appropriations and the Committee on Economic Development. It is the intent of I Mina'Trenta Na Liheslaturan Guåhan, however, to clarify the appropriate referral, and therefore, to amend the Standing Rules to reflect such clarity; and

WHEREAS, Section 6.04.04.02, titled "Appropriations," is amended to read as follows: "Section 6.04.04.02. Appropriations. Substantive bills which contain appropriations or authorizations for appropriations shall be referred to the Committee on Appropriations. The annual budget bill for the government and supplements to the annual budget bill, shall be referred to the Committee on Appropriations. Any bills on bonds of any nature shall be referred jointly to the Committee on Economic Development, the Judiciary, and Health, and to the Committee on Appropriations; the joint committees shall have a joint hearing and a single report shall issue on those bills by a majority vote of the joint committee. Each year the chairperson shall designate one appropriations bill as the annual budget bill and may designate one bill as the supplemental annual budget bill. The annual budget bill shall be done annually, and shall contain the budget for one fiscal year only. Unrelated appropriations shall not be
