1 BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA' TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN

- 3 **WHEREAS**, the practice of having session meetings of *I Liheslaturan*
- 4 Guåhan during the late night hours has been criticized on numerous
- 5 occasions over the years; and
- 6 WHEREAS, it is desirable that the public be aware of the actions of
- 7 the government at the times that they are taken and these actions should be
- 8 taken at times that are easily accessible to the public; and
- 9 WHEREAS, late night work hours and excessively long work hours
- are not conducive to good performance, whether by government officials
- 11 or other workers; and
- 12 WHEREAS, the practice of late night sessions and long hours have
- 13 frequently been linked with a lack of transparency in our government, even

- 1 when they are caused by impending deadlines associated with the passage
- 2 of the government budget; and
- 3 WHEREAS, although they are carried on cable television, late night
- 4 and overnight sessions are difficult for the public to follow when actions
- 5 are taken in the early-morning hours, well after most people have retired
- 6 for the evening; and
- WHEREAS, I Liheslatura should be able to plan its session schedule in
- 8 such a fashion that its work is accomplished transparently, and at times
- 9 when the majority of the island's population is able to follow the debate,
- 10 either from the Public Hearing Room or on the cable channel 13, now,
- 11 therefore, be it
- 12 **RESOLVED,** that I Mina'Trente Na Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby
- 13 add a new § 4.02.05 to Rule IV, Convening and Sessions, of Mina'Trenta na
- 14 Liheslaturan Guåhan's Otden Ariklamento (Thirtieth Guam Legislature's
- 15 Standing Rules) to require sessions to be held between 7:00 a.m. and 10:00
- 16 p.m. on each calendar or session day that session is convened; and be it

- 18 **RESOLVED**, that the new Section 4.02.05 shall read:
- "Section 4.02.05. Sessions to be held between 7:00 a.m. and 10:00
- 20 p.m. Convening of sessions and continuation of session meetings shall be
- 21 after 7:00 a.m. each calendar day, and each session shall be recessed or
