Relative to memorializing and acknowledging the accomplishments of former Assemblyman, Senator, Commissioner, businessman, and master lanceru, the late Honorable Alfred San Nicolas Flores, on the occasion of his passing, and offering condolences to his family.

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN

2 GUÅHAN:

3 WHEREAS, our island has suffered the loss of one of its most
4 prominent sons and island citizen with the passing of the Honorable Alfred
5 San Nicolas Flores; and

6 WHEREAS, on June 20, 1916, the Honorable Alfred San Nicolas
7 Flores was born to Jose Duenas Flores and Rafaela Lujan San Nicolas and
8 was raised by his stepmother Margarita L. Flores; and

9 WHEREAS, the Honorable Alfred San Nicolas Flores was married to
10 Ester Paulino Duenas Flores on February 18, 1939, and were blessed with
11 three children, Mrs. Lucille Flores Leon Guerrero, Mrs. May Flores-Hannah

1 Mr. Fred Flores, and reared son Mr. Roy P. Duenas; ten (10) grandchildren,
2 Giovanna, Alfred, Mark, Brian, Ester, Tina, David, Anna Maria, Tera and
3 Fred; and thirteen (13) great grandchildren, Kristen, Danielle, Aaron,
4 Giana, Alfred, Sophia, Olivia, David, Rachael, Johnalyn, Brianne, Erwin Jr.,
5 and Aubrey; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the Honorable Alfred San Nicolas Flores was a man of
7 humble beginnings, a businessman and a well known master *lancheru* by
8 profession; and

9 **WHEREAS**, the Honorable Alfred San Nicolas Flores as a master
10 *lancheru*, tended hundreds acres of land, raised 800 head of carabao and
11 cattle, cultivated and seeded fruits and vegetables, and established the
12 Flores Poultry Farm with 200 chickens which grew to a staggering 75,000
13 chickens and producing 70, 000 eggs a day; and

14 **WHEREAS**, the Honorable Alfred San Nicolas Flores worked
15 throughout his life serving his community and advancing the public good,
16 serving with honor and distinction as an Assemblyman in the Pre-organic
17 Act Congress, as a Senator to the Fourth, Fifth, Seventh, Ninth and Tenth
18 Guam Legislatures; and as Commissioner (Mayor) of Inarajan for one term
19 in 1976.; and

20 **WHEREAS**, the Honorable Alfred San Nicolas Flores was a pioneer in
21 the political landscape of Guam being part of a group that founded the
22 Democratic party of Guam and was well known for his “off the cuff” and
23 passionate campaign speeches that earned him the name “Davy Crockett”;
24 and

1 **WHEREAS**, during his tenure as senator, the Honorable Alfred San
2 Nicolas Flores authored public laws that built subdivisions in Astumbo,
3 Inarajan, Talofoyo, Merizo and Umatac as well what is now Inarajan
4 Middle School, as a man of the land he fought for the advancement of the
5 farming community by reducing the water rates for farmers and
6 establishing farmer's insurance; and

7 **WHEREAS**, the Honorable Alfred San Nicolas Flores served on
8 various boards and commission including the Selective Service Board,
9 which he was a member for twenty-one (21) years; the Guam Housing and
10 Urban Renewal Authority Board of Directors; the Guam Farmers
11 Cooperative Association; and the Soil and Water Conservation District; and

12 **WHEREAS**, the Honorable Alfred San Nicolas Flores has been active
13 in numerous civic and religious organizations including the Parish Council
14 and Holy Name Society at Saint Joseph's Church in Inarajan and the Boy
15 Scouts of America; and now, therefore, be it

16 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trenta Na*
17 *Lihselaturan Guahan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Lihselaturan Guahan* and the
18 people of Guam, does hereby recognize and acknowledge the
19 accomplishments and achievements of the late Honorable Alfred San
20 Nicolas Flores, a pioneer in Guam politics and a fighter for the people; and
21 be it further

22 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trenta Na*
23 *Lihselaturan Guahan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Lihselaturan Guahan* and the
24 people of Guam, does hereby extend its condolences and heartfelt

1 sympathy to the family of the late Honorable Alfred San Nicolas Flores on
2 his passing and be it further

3 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker, and the Secretary of the Legislature
4 attest to, the adoption hereof and that copies of the same be thereafter
5 transmitted to his widow, Mrs. Ester Paulino Duenas Flores; his children
6 Mrs. Lucille Flores Leon Guerrero, Mrs. May Flores-Hannah, Mr. Fred
7 Flores, and Roy P. Duenas; the mayor of Inarajan, the Honorable Franklin
8 M. Taitague; and to the Honorable Felix P. Camacho, I *Maga 'lahen Gudhan*.
