RELATIVE TO RECOGNIZING THE EXTRAORDINARY SUPPORT AND GENEROSITY THE IGLESIA NI 2009 MAR - 3 PH 4: 09 CRISTO, (CHURCH OF CHRIST) HAS PROVIDED THE LOCAL COMMUNITY FOR OVER FORTY (40) YEARS, AND EXTENDS A UN DANGKOLO' NA SI YU'OS MA'ASE' AND MARAMING SALAMAT PO' FOR ITS WONDERFUL CONTRIBUTION TO THE PEOPLE OF GUAM: FURTHER **EXTENDS** SPECIAL Α COMMENDATION AND CONGRATULATIONS TO THE ENTIRE IGLESIAS NI CRISTO, CHURCH OF CHRIST, BOTH ON GUAM AND INTERNATIONALLY FOR THE TREMENDOUS LOVE AND COMMITMENT IT HAS PROVIDED ITS FAMILY MEMBERS AND THE PEOPLE OF GUAM; AND FINALLY EXTENDS GUAM'S BEST WISHES FOR MANY MORE SUCCESSFUL YEARS IN THE FUTURE IN STRENGTHENING FAMILIES AND BRINGING INDIVIDUALS AND MEMBERS CLOSER TO CHRIST AND THE IGLESIAS NI CRISTO CHURCH.

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA' TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN 2 GUÅHAN:

3 WHEREAS, in 1960, seven contract workers of US Naval Installation

4 Facilities were the founding group members of the *Iglesia Ni Cristo* (Church

of Christ) while they congregated at their barracks in Camp Roxas, Agat, for
 regular prayer and social gatherings; and

3 WHEREAS, The *Iglesia Ni Cristo* (Church of Christ) congregation was 4 officially registered on Guam as a religious church organization with the 5 government of Guam on March 17, 1969, and has henceforth celebrated its 6 anniversary on this date in recognition of its years of service to the people of 7 Guam; and

8 WHEREAS, the first large prayer service was held in 1963 with more 9 than 50 members who met in a rented Quonset hut located along Marine 10 Drive in Tamuning; and

WHEREAS, in 1965, due to the increased interest in Guamanians joining the church and the need to identify a more formal church facility, the place of worship was relocated to the residence of Brother Luciano Hipolito, who additionally served as the first deacon of the local church congregation; and

WHEREAS, Guam's first residential minister, the late Brother Liberato
Panares, arrived from the Philippines on November 29, 1969; and shortly
thereafter, the late Brother Aniceto S. Bunag, presided over the construction
of a semi-concrete church on Route 16 in Harmon, Dededo; and

WHEREAS, in 1973 with a growing church congregation which now encompassed more than one hundred fifty (150) religious members, the late Brother Cipriano P. Sandoval, General Secretary of the Iglesia Ni Cristo, visited Guam from the central office of the Iglesias Ni Cristo (Church of Christ) in New Era, Quezon City, Philippines, to officiate a special worship service dedicating the official church building and the adjacent properties which were acquired by the local church members through their hard work
 and financial commitment; and

3 WHEREAS, the increasing number of church members lead to the 4 formation of a separate church gathering and building, located in Apra 5 Heights, Santa Rita in 1984; and

6 WHEREAS, in recognition of the continuing growth in the number of 7 church members, it was the wish and desire of the local congregation to 8 provide a much larger and better accommodating house of worship facility 9 that will enable church members to more comfortably worship and share 10 time with fellow church members; this strong desire for a larger facility resulted in the eventual approval for the construction of a new house of 11 12 worship with the generous support of the administration of the Iglesias Ni 13 Cristo; and

14 WHEREAS, the construction of the present House of Worship in Harmon, Dededo, commenced on February 22, 1993, with a generous 15 investment of approximately \$2.1 million by the local community of 16 17 believers; the elegant and stylish edifice which provides for a seating capacity 18 of at least six hundred (600) along with adjacent meeting rooms was officially opened and dedicated to God and church members on March 19, 1994, and 19 today serves as the spiritual sanctuary for more than one thousand (1,000) 20worshipers on Wednesdays, Thursdays and Sundays; and 21

WHEREAS, the magnificent church structure reflects the holiness and sanctity of the Iglesias Ni Cristo - Church of Christ and the sacredness of its mission; and furthermore today, represents one of the most conspicuous and remarkable landmarks in Guam; and 1 WHEREAS, the *Iglesia Ni Cristo* – Church of Christ for much more 2 than forty years of existence in Guam brought spiritual development and 3 maturity to the entire island community, to include predominantly Filipinos 4 and other ethnic cultures, and has also shared in the burden of addressing the 5 island's social and economic concerns; and

6 WHEREAS, as a religious institution, *Iglesia Ni Cristo's* role in society
7 serves as a pillar that inculcates brotherly and sisterly love among its church
8 members and all people; and

9 WHEREAS, on March 17, 2009, the *Iglesia Ni Cristo* – Church of 10 Christ, Guam, will be commemorating and celebrating its 40th anniversary of 11 serving and supporting the people of Guam through its numerous prayer 12 services and community activities; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Committee on Rules of I Mina Trenta Na Liheslaturan Guahan does hereby, on behalf of I Liheslaturan Guahan and the People of Guam, recognize the extraordinary support and contribution that the Iglesias Ni Cristo – Church of Christ has provided the community of Guam for over forty (40) years, and extends a warmhearted **Un Dangkolo' Na Si yu'os Ma'ase' and Maraming Salamat Po'** to its church ministers, leaders and the entire congregation; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Committee on Rules of I Mina Trenta Na Liheslaturan Guahan does further extends, on behalf of the people of Guam, its commendations and congratulations to the Iglesias Ni Cristo – Church of Christ on Guam and Internationally for the tremendous love and commitment it has provided its family members and the people of Guam for the past 40 years; and additionally extends Guam's best wishes for many more successful years in the future in strengthening families and bringing individuals and members closer to
 Christ and the Iglesias Ni Cristo Church; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on
Rules and the Secretary of the Legislature attest the adoption hereof and that
copies of the same be transmitted to Iglesias Ni Cristo Executive Minister Erano
G. Manalo, Philippines; Brother Jose J. Ventilacion, Resident Minister of *Iglesia Ni Cristo*, Guam; to the Honorable Olivia Palala, Consul General of the
Philippines, Guam; and to the Honorable Felix P. Camacho, I Maga'lahen *Guåhan*.
