WHEREAS, Ms. Sixta Rose M. Santos was born on July 16, 1960 in *Tamuning*. She is the daughter of †Mr. Juan Santos Santos and Mrs. Maria Manibusan Santos of *Chalan Pago*, Guam. Ms. Sixta Rose M. Santos is the eleventh (11th) of thirteen children: seven (7) sisters – Mrs. Margaret S. Aguon, Mrs. Julie S. Sablan, Mrs. Virginia S. Manley, Mrs. Marylou S. Gogo, Ms. Bertha M. Santos, Mrs. Patricia S. Chargualaf, and Ms. Karen M. Santos and five (5) brothers – Mr. William John M. Santos, Mr. Joe M. Santos, Mr. Francisco M. Santos and Mr. Norman M. Santos; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Sixta Rose M. Santos was educated in the Island's public school system and graduated from George Washington High School in 1979; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Sixta Rose M. Santos and Mr. Frank A. Torre, the son of †Mr. Antonio Nauta Torre and Mrs. Felicidad Aguon Torre, have been blessed with a daughter, Miss Felicia M. Torre; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Sixta Rose M. Santos' career with the government began at the Department of Revenue and Taxation in March 1980 as a Clerk, and while employed with the Agency for Human Resources and Development (AHRD), under a (CETA) Title II D grant, Ms. Santos was promoted from a Clerk Typist I to a Clerk Typist II. She proved to be a remarkable woman who combines all the qualities necessary to make her a topnotch employee. Ms. Santos' tireless and efficient work with the Department of Revenue and Taxation warranted recognition of her work and dedication and was recommended to be employed with the government on a full-time permanent basis; and

WHEREAS, in July 1980, Ms. Sixta Rose M. Santos became a permanent government employee as a Clerk Typist II at the Department of Revenue and Taxation and transferred to the Department of Administration (DOA) under the Division of Personnel Management. Her invaluable hard work while employed at the Department of Administration was evident by receiving Meritorious Salary Increments

September 1982, December 1986 and September 1991. Ms. Santos' consistent progression through the rank and file from a Clerk Typist II, a Clerk Typist III, a Work Processing Secretary I, a Word Processing Secretary II, a Customer Service Representative culminated to her current position as a Personnel Assistant II since January 2005, continued this pattern of outstanding services. This is evidenced by the numerous outstanding performance awards granted to Ms. Santos by a number of her supervisors over the span of twenty-nine (29) years of service; and
