



**RELATIVE TO COMMENDING THE SERVE GUAM
COMMISSION FOR IMPROVING LIVES,
STRENGTHENING COMMUNITIES, AND FOSTERING
CIVIC ENGAGEMENT THROUGH SERVICE AND
VOLUNTEERING AND RECOGNIZING APRIL 19-25
2009, AS NATIONAL VOLUNTEER WEEK.**

1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I MINA'**
2 **TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:**

3 **WHEREAS,** National Volunteer Week was created in 1974 when
4 President Richard Nixon signed an executive order to establish the week as an
5 annual celebration of volunteering; **and**

6 **WHEREAS,** National Volunteer Week reflects the power that volunteers
7 have to "inspire by example" volunteers both encourage those they help and
8 motivate others to serve and "celebrating people in action"; **and**

9 **WHEREAS,** the act also formally launched AmeriCorps, a network of
10 national service programs that engage Americans in intensive service to meet

1 the nation's critical needs in education, environment, public safety, health,
2 and other unmet human needs. The newly created AmeriCorps incorporated
3 two existing national service programs: the longstanding VISTA (Volunteers
4 in Service To America) program, created by President Lyndon Johnson in 1964
5 and the National Civilian Community Corps (NCCC); and

6 **WHEREAS**, the Serve Guam Commission, AmeriCorps Programs;
7 AmeriCorps University of Guam Success Center; Sanctuary, Incorporated –
8 Ayuda Para I Komunidat, Micronesian Business Association – Impact Today!,
9 Pa'a AmeriCorps Community Linala y Kuturan Chamorro, Governor's Guam
10 Volunteer Center in partnership with University of Guam, and Guam
11 AmeriCorps Alumni Chapter; **and**

12 **WHEREAS**, our island community will host 2009 National Volunteer
13 Week beginning Sunday, April 19th and ending on April 25th 2009, with the
14 office of *I Maga'lahaen Guåhan* in the promotion of community outreach and
15 civic engagement; **and**

16 **WHEREAS**, National Volunteer Awards will be presented to all
17 organizations of all stripes – nonprofits, faith based, community groups,
18 Volunteer Centers, businesses, and local government agencies, to include
19 Guam Memorial Hospital Volunteer Association, Military Partner's; Navy
20 Joint Region Marianas, U.S. Air Force, Guam Veterans Organization's;;
21 American Legion Post #1, Military Order of the Purple Heart 2006, Army
22 Retirees Association, Agana Shopping Center, Micronesia Mall, Non-Profit,

1 Faith Based Organizations, Public and Private Schools; community
2 volunteer's and other community partners in recognition of volunteers
3 throughout the 2009 year; and be it

4 **WHEREAS**, National Volunteer week's events include; Sunday, April
5 19th, Thank –A-Volunteer – Thanking the Volunteers of Guam, Monday, April
6 20th, AmeriCorps Cares; AmeriCorps Members provides special treats to
7 Guam Memorial Hospital, Tuesday,- Friday, April 21-24th, AmeriCorps Reads;
8 AmeriCorps members, along with Clifford & other costumed characters, read
9 at various kindergarten classes, Saturday, April 25th, AmeriCorps Celebrates
10 Life; AmeriCorps members sing, entertain and assist St. Dominic's residents,

13 Commission for improving lives, strengthening communities, and fostering
14 civic engagement through service and volunteering and recognizes April 19-
