
## I MINA' TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN 2009 Regular Session

WHEREAS, Dr. Rosa Carter graduated from George Washington High School in 1950. In 1953 she received her Bachelor of Science degree from Northern State University, Aberdeen, South Dakota and she had a double major in history and Elementary Education. In addition in 1958 she earned her diploma and certification in Education and completed a Comparative Education at Sydney University, Sydney,

12 Australia and she was a Fulbright Fellow.

WHEREAS, Dr. Rosa Carter earned her Master of Arts in Guidance and Counseling in 1962 at Northern Colorado University, Greeley, Colorado. And in 1976 Dr. Rosa Carter earned her Doctor of Philosophy in Education Supervision at Bowling Green State University, Bowling Green, Ohio.

- of Women's Club, Soroptimist International of Guam, Association of University
