1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA' TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN**

3 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Rosa Carter is the daughter of Jose Duenas Roberto and
4 Antonia Santos Garrido Roberto of which both of them are deceased. She has three
5 brothers and five sisters and her husband is Dr. Lee D. Carter, a retired university
6 professor.

7 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Rosa Carter graduated from George Washington High School
8 in 1950. In 1953 she received her Bachelor of Science degree from Northern State
9 University, Aberdeen, South Dakota and she had a double major in history and
10 Elementary Education. In addition in 1958 she earned her diploma and certification in
11 Education and completed a Comparative Education at Sydney University, Sydney,
12 Australia and she was a Fulbright Fellow.

13 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Rosa Carter earned her Master of Arts in Guidance and
14 Counseling in 1962 at Northern Colorado University, Greeley, Colorado. And in
15 1976 Dr. Rosa Carter earned her Doctor of Philosophy in Education Supervision at
16 Bowling Green State University, Bowling Green, Ohio.

1 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Rosa Carter career as a professional leader is reflected in her
2 years as an elementary teacher for Government of Guam; a high school teacher for the
3 Catholic Schools; Assistant Principal at Wettengel Elementary School; an Associate
4 Professor at the University of Guam teaching English, Chamorro, Educational
5 courses, Psychology, test and measurement, guidance and counseling classes at the
6 graduate level.

7 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Rosa Carter had served in many positions at the University of
8 Guam in many capacities before becoming President from 1977 to 1983.

9 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Rosa Carter's dissertation was: An Analysis of Teachers'
10 Demographic Functional Efficiency to include other research which included: Island
11 and Personal History, Guam History Perspectives, Co-Editor, Guam History,
12 Perspectives, Vol.1, 1997 and Vol. 2, 2005, University of Guam; Padre Palomo Park
13 Syllabus for Historic Preservation Trust in 2008.

14 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Rosa Carter has many years in public service as well as
15 community service which included; Girl Scouts, American Red Cross, Guam Council
16 of Women's Club, Soroptimist International of Guam, Association of University
17 Women, a member of Delta Kappa since 1978 and is the sole Proprietor of Carter
18 Consulting company, Inc.

19 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Rosa Carter is a recipient of numerous awards to include;
20 Distinguished Alumni Award from Northern State University, Fulbright Scholarship
21 with Sydney University, Phi Delta Kappa, Guam Chapter and Resolution #11-2002
22 Board of Trustees from Guam Community College only to name a few.
