- 7 father, another local successful respected musician on Guam. RoseAna began
- 8 her musical success on Guam performing initially with the Piti Middle School
- 9 Combo Band, continuing with the George Washington High School Concert
- 10 Band as a percussionist. RoseAna also joined other talented youths in the
- 11 Island Honor Band where they competed in Hawaii in 2000; and
- WHEREAS, RoseAna joined various independent grass root bands such
- 13 as Sticky and Blame Adam to progress her musical abilities. As a young

passionate local female, she set out to advance her musical aspirations by 1

moving to Chicago City in 2001 at the young age of 19; and 2

WHEREAS, RoseAna auditioned and now selected for the lead guitar position for an all girls band called Cat Fight. From that moment into the next several years her musical career flourished in the various venues and night clubs in Chicago and branched out to neighboring states; and

WHEREAS, RoseAna at age 26, developed a professional musicianship and reputation that was soon recognized and acknowledged by other respected bands and local musicians; and

WHEREAS, it became apparent and destined that another rising band sought her out to form the top premier band called "DOT DOT", consisting of RoseAna Laguana-lead guitarist, vocals; Adam Blair-guitarist, lead vocals; Little Lisa- bass, vocals; Michael-Key Boards; and Stephandrums. Several months later, "DOT DOT DOT" was invited to compete and represent Chicago and her Island of Guam on a nationally televised show called "The Next Great American Band 2007; and

WHEREAS, the band "DOT DOT DOT" finished in the top five out of thousands of competitive bands throughout the United States.
