WHEREAS, the month of May has been recognized as National Museum Month by thousands of museum organizations, communities, and states across the country, as well as by the White House and Congress for more than two decades;

WHEREAS, the Guam Museum Foundation, Inc. and the Guam Museum Facilities Construction and Cultural Heritage Rehabilitation Task Force, joins the American Association of Museums, a conglomerate of members throughout the United States and its territories in commemorating and celebrating the history and tradition of our ancestors; and

WHEREAS, museums are the inheritors and guardians of the people's remnants, and artifacts; and

WHEREAS, museums are promoters of culture, history, tradition, and are centers of research for scholars, of education, as well as a resource for schools, colleges, universities, libraries, and other institutions of learning; and

WHEREAS, our local community, together with museum officials, will celebrate Guam Museum Month with the theme of "I Hinanao-ta" the Journey of the Chamorro people to commemorate the contributions made by the Guam Museum to the preservation of our heritage — culture, arts, and history — and to the furtherance and understanding of the people of Guam; and

WHEREAS, museums enrich the quality of our communities, provide a sense of place and offer enlightenment for younger generations; and

WHEREAS, Guam has seen a renewed interest in preserving the island's rich heritage and it is notable that our island's landscape holds several existing museums, as well as a few anticipated museum openings in the near futures, including the Guam Museum, the National Park Service War in the Pacific Museum, the U'Zeum Children's Discovery Museum of Guam, the Pacific War Museum, the National Museum of the Dulce Nombre de Maria Cathedral-Basilica, the Micronesian Area Research Center at the University of Guam and the highly anticipated Guam Museum of Culture Arts, and History; and

WHEREAS, it is also worthy to acknowledge the strong partnerships created by the Department of *Chamorro* Affairs, the Guam Council on the Arts and Humanities Agency with its Steering Committee collaborators, and all of Guam's community organizations that continue to carry out the mission to protect, preserve, perpetuate and promote the *Chamorro* culture and heritage not only during Guam Museum Month but every day; now, therefore, be it
