3 WHEREAS, May 4 – 10, 2009 has been designated as “National Public
4 Service Recognition Week; and

5 WHEREAS, thousands of government employees contribute daily to the
6 quality of life for the citizens of the territory of Guam. These men and women, with
7 their commitment to excellence and diversity of skills, are an invaluable resource; and

11 our environment and performing management activities which are essential to
